Wausau, **WI** Leinie's Guy Deano Radke announced on Thursday that his rehabilitation after his recent knee replacement is way ahead of schedule.


Stated Radke, "I don't think my vertical leap was ever much over 25 inches with my old knee, but with this new one...holy cow! I can really get up there."
